EGGSHELL PLANTER

What You Need

- Egg carton
- Eggshell
- Potting soil and seed (preferably wheat grass seed)
- Markers or other art materials

Instructions

1. Cut egg carton apart to create a holder and place eggshell inside.
2. Fill eggshell with potting soil.
3. Add seed to the soil, water, and let it grow for about a week.
4. Carefully remove eggshell from egg carton holder and set aside.
5. Cut away one section of the egg carton to use as a base for your planter. Then cut a hole in the bottom (big enough for your eggshell to sit comfortably), turn it upside down, and trim the "legs" for stability. Place your eggshell planter in the hole.
6. Use markers or other materials to decorate your eggshell planter and base.
