WAC-A-MOLE

What You Need

- Shoebox
- 8½" x 11" paper
- Sticks
- Tape
- Scissors
- Paper cups
- Marker

Instructions

1. Use the top of the cup as a stencil to draw four or more circles on the bottom of the shoebox.
2. Cut out the circles.
3. Remove the top of the box and one side, keeping the remaining three sides intact.
4. Fold the paper into quarters and cut to make four squares. Cut enough squares for the number of holes in the bottom of the box.
5. Fold each square in half twice so there are four squares creased into the paper.
6. With the square folded at its smallest shape, cut from the inside edge to create a slit inside the square that does not go all the way to the edge. Then cut a similar slit along the other crease. This will result in a T cut into the unfolded square.
7. Tape or glue the paper squares on the inside of the box for each circle. Make sure not to cover the T in the paper (this is where the mole comes through).
8. Poke a hole in the bottom of both cups and attach the stick from the inside.
9. Decorate one cup as a mole and one as a hammer.

WAC-A-MOLE

How To Play

1. This is a two-player game—one player is the mole and one player is the hammer.
2. Set a timer. Once it starts, the mole player will raise the mole through different holes.
3. When the mole appears through the hole, the hammer player tries to hit it before it disappears.
4. During the allotted time, keep score on how many times the mole is hit.
5. Switch players and see who can score the highest.
