New This Week

Subgrade Corrections Nearly Complete In Area 1; Sewer Work Continues In Area 2

Last Week

Last week in Area 1, crews completed subgrade correction on all streets with the exception of the Idaho/Glenwood Ave and Hampshire/Glenwood Ave intersections. Those will be completed early next week.

In Area 2, crews from Visu-Sewer continue to install liners in the City's sanitary sewer mains. Residents are asked to check their lower level floor drains to make sure water is in them to prevent any odors from entering

the house. This work will continue for the next few weeks.

Coming Up

Curb and gutter has been scheduled for the week of June 16 in Area 1. Please remember you will not be able to drive on the concrete for seven days but you will be able to park in front of your home each night. At night, try to park on one side of the street to allow room for emergency vehicles.

After the curb and gutter has cured, crews will begin placing gravel in preparation for paving. Weather permitting, base course paving is scheduled for the week of June 23.

In Area 2, utility work is scheduled to begin the week of June 30.



Reminders

Deadline For Area 2 Driveway Estimates Is June 30

Residents living in Area 2 have until June 30 to request a driveway estimate.

The deadline for requesting a driveway estimate has passed for residents in Area 1.

If you choose to take part in the City's driveway program, you have the opportunity to reconstruct the rest of your driveway (blacktop or concrete) as part of the project at the same prices paid by the City, plus an administrative fee.

If you are in Area 2 and interested in replacing your driveway as part of the City's street reconstruction project, call Public Works at 763-593-8030 to request a driveway estimate.

Area 2 Residents: Please Move Irrigation Systems, Invisible Fencing Now

Many homeowners have installed irrigation systems and/or invisible fencing adjacent to the street. Because these private irrigation and fence systems are within City street right-of-way (ROW), they are in the path of the reconstruction project and must be moved.

To avoid spending tax dollars to relocate private irrigation and fence systems, homeowners are responsible for temporarily moving or relocating their own systems. This work should be taken care of before crews start working on your street.

City staff suggests that you remove sprinkler heads and plug lines that are located within 15 feet of the existing street and pull the pipe ends up so they can be easily seen. You will still be responsible for repairing any irrigation or fencing systems you

have placed in the ROW, but these suggestions will minimize costs for replacing the systems later on.

SCHEDULES MAY CHANGE ON SHORT NOTICE Weather, delays by subcontractors, or other unforeseen events can cause schedule changes. The contractor makes an effort to notify residents as soon as possible for situations where utility or driveway access restrictions may be experienced.

CHECK DOORS FOR NOTICES The contractor will routinely notify you about upcoming work, particularly if the work will make your driveway inaccessible for most or part of a day (you will be able to get back into your driveway each evening). Please check all of the doors around your house for written notices of upcoming work.

RECYCLING Recycling should be picked up as scheduled. Please continue to have your recycling curbside by 7 am on Fridays of your service week. The recycling contractor will collect recycling in street reconstruction areas on schedule. Please continue to report all missed pick-ups to Allied Waste at 952-941-5174.
