

Inflow & Infiltration (I/I) Program Acknowledgement Form

The City of Golden Valley received a permit application for sewer repairs at the below listed property. It is the City's practice to provide the following information about the Inflow and Infiltration program (the "Program") to the property owner whenever an application for sewer repair is received.

I/I Ordinance Process

- To comply with Metropolitan Council Environmental Services Division (MCES) directives regarding Inflow and Infiltration ("I/I"), the City inspects homes and businesses in Golden Valley to determine if roof drains, foundation drains, sump pumps, and other clear water sources are connected to the sanitary sewer system. The goal of this program is to reduce excessive flows that enter the sanitary sewer system so the City, and its utility customers, won't have to pay MCES surcharges.
- City of Golden Valley I/I requirements are contained in City Code section 28-50. The ordinance requires owners to obtain a Certificate of Inflow and Infiltration Compliance prior to sale of the property.
- If your property does not yet have a Certificate of Inflow and Infiltration Compliance, you must request a sanitary sewer inspection prior to sale of the property. Any defects identified during the inspection must be repaired before the property can be sold.
- It may be cost effective to complete an I/I Inspection and any required repairs in conjunction with the sewer repairs authorized under the requested permit.
- I/I inspection reports are valid for one year from the date of issuance.

• Steps for I/I Permit

1. Apply for an I/I permit. There is a \$250 inspection fee.
2. Call for an inspection at 763-593-3962.
3. City staff inspects the internal plumbing and sanitary sewer lateral and generates a report.
4. The property owner can choose to make the repairs identified in the report or wait until the property sells, at which time the process starts over if longer than a year.
5. After repairs are completed, staff re-inspects the sanitary sewer lateral to make sure all repairs have been done correctly.
6. Staff issues a Certificate of Inflow and Infiltration Compliance.
