All pick-ups are at Golden Valley City Hall under the water tower.

Art Deco and Art of Charles M Schulz | Wed, Feb 7

Arrive at the 4th Street Entrance of St. Paul City Hall for an Art Deco Tour. All guests must go through security. The driver will stay on the bus so your belongings will be secure. Take a tour of the Ramsey County Courthouse and Saint Paul City Hall. Tour the architecturally significant spaces and features within Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse. It is a 21-story Art Deco skyscraper, which opened to the public in 1932. The building serves as the main location for Minnesota's Second Judicial Court and City Hall. It contains The Vision of Peace, the world's largest carved onyx statue. The building has 23 kinds of wood from 18 countries and various marbles throughout. This is a working building; not all rooms are available to tour at all times. The building is subject to security issues and government regulations that may require last-minute restrictions and changes.

Board the motor coach at the 4th St entrance of St. Paul City Hall. Arrive at Degidio's Restaurant for lunch. Menu: Parmesan Crusted Chicken Breast served over Spaghetti with Tomato Sauce and Baked Mozzarella, and Garlic Bread.

Leave Degidio's Restaurant. Arrive at the History Center in St. Paul (Bus will drop off and pick up at the Kellogg Blvd entrance, next to parking lot). This is a self-guided experience. Spend time at the exhibit, The Life and Art of Charles M. Schulz. Walk through the space and explore Schulz's personal history, his role as the inspiration and artistic talent.

Sinatra – My Way at St Cloud Paramount Theater | Tue, Mar 12

Arrive for lunch at Coyote Moon Grille Restaurant overlooking the Territory Golf Club in St. Cloud. Menu includes an entrée, popover, salad, side dish, beverage, and dessert.

Leave the Coyote Moon Grill Restaurant. Arrive at the Paramount Theatre in St. Cloud, a turn-of-the-century historic 700-seat theater that was renovated in 1998. Visit the Visual Arts Center, located in the lower level of the Paramount Theatre. Next door is the Paramount Gallery and Gift Store, featuring Minnesota Artists in All Mediums.

Be seated for *Sinatra – My Way*, with Andrew Walesch and his Orchestra. Like a good many before him, singer and pianist Andrew Walesch somehow manages to encapsulate the sophistication of a cosmopolite and the self-effacing charm of a country boy. Whether composing and arranging or appearing in settings ranging from solo artist to big band, this St. Cloud, Minnesota native, who criss-crosses the country playing dates big and small, is as respectful of his predecessors as he is ready to take a leap into the unknown and chart a new course. In his monthly, sold-out shows with his 10-piece band, Walesch is a traditionalist and an iconoclast rolled into one. His audiences include jazz enthusiasts of a certain age, as well as a younger crowd compelled by his down-home insouciance, and the knowing irreverence of a tried-and-true American nightclub entertainer. His vocal and piano chops, along with his keen sensibility to find and interpret a great lyric, have led to some great opportunities for Walesch, including an appearance on the nationally syndicated NPR broadcast Mountain Stage and more recently, an invitation to perform at the 33rd Annual Cabaret Convention at the Rose Theater at Jazz at Lincoln Center in New York City. In 2023, Andrew accepted the position of artistic director of the MIM Music Theater in Phoenix, Arizona where he now resides.

Enjoy imaginative floral interpretations of selected works of art from Minneapolis Institute of Art's permanent collection, created by more than 100 commercial florists and individual artists. Guests are invited to experience the floral fragrance throughout the museum. This is a self-guided experience throughout the campus. Browse floral-inspired merchandise in the Art In Bloom Pop-up Shop, and visit the Gift Store and Café.

Minneapolis Institute of Art inspires wonder through the power of art. MIA enriches the community by collecting, preserving, and making accessible outstanding works of art from the world's diverse cultures. In 1883, 25 citizens of Minneapolis founded the Minneapolis Society of Fine Arts, committing them to bringing the arts into the life of their community. More than a century later, the museum they created, the Minneapolis Institute of Art, stands as a monument to a remarkable history of civic involvement and cultural achievements. MIA's permanent collection has grown from 800 works of art to more than 89,000 objects. The collection includes world-famous works that embody the highest levels of artistic achievement, our objects span from about 20,000 BCE and representing the world's diverse cultures across six continents. The museum has seven curatorial areas: Arts of Africa and the Americas; Contemporary Art; Decorative Arts, Textiles and Sculpture; Asian Art; Paintings; Photography and New Media; and Prints and Drawings.

Leave MIA and arrive at Jax Café in Minneapolis. Take the elevator to the Cosmopolitan Room on the second floor for lunch, which includes baked chicken with mashed potatoes, gravy, vegetable, chocolate mousse, coffee, tea or milk. Tables will be assigned to each bus group in attendance. Jax Café has been serving Minnesotans since 1933. It's a landmark that was established by Stanley Kozlak. He left Poland as a teenager and established a restaurant business that would support three generations after him.
