## BOARD/COMMISSION RESULTS

### Mostly 1s

#### Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA)

Reviews and makes decisions on zoning-related matters, providing a space for property owners or applicants to present their case and seek relief from certain zoning restrictions or requirements

### Mostly 2s

#### Community Services Commission (CSC)

Assists at events to help raise money for human service needs in the community and advises City Council on fund allocation

### Mostly 3s

#### Diversity, Equity, & Inclusion Commission (DEIC)

Advises, recommends, and assists City Council in matters related to diversity, equity, inclusion, and human rights

### Mostly 4s

#### Environmental Commission (EC)

Advises and makes recommendations to City Council in matters relating to and affecting the environment

### Mostly 5s

#### Open Space & Recreation Commission (OSRC)

Advises, recommends, and assists City Council in policies and plans related to open space needs, parks and recreation programs, trail systems, and Brookview Golf Course

### Mostly 6s

#### Planning Commission (PC)

Advises, recommends, and assists City Council in planning and growth opportunities throughout the city, including issues related to the social, economic, and physical environment

### Mostly 7s

#### Police Employment, Accountability, & Community Engagement (PEACE) Commission

Makes recommendations to City Council on matters related to policing in Golden Valley
