Why Update?

Golden Valley's parking code hadn't been revised since the 1980s and was updated to:

- remove vague requirements and modernize the language
- require "greener" parking lots when building new developments
- incentivize multi-modal transportation (walk, bike, bus)
- reduce parking minimums as outlined in the Zoning For Equity Report
- implement the Downtown User Experience Framework
- align with Strategic Plan Goal #5—Strategic (Re)Development

What Was Updated

Updates include:

- removing garage requirements for lots under 50 feet in width.
- removing parking requirements for ADUs
- requiring bike parking for apartments
- requiring less parking for commercial uses
- implementing maximum parking for commercial uses
- reducing parking requirements near transit and trails
- More landscaping and more pedestrian walkways required in new lots
